



## Malts from Islay...

<b>Bunnahabhain</b>	<b>12 Year Old</b>	<b>43.3% abv</b>	<b>£5.00</b>
<i>Breathe in:</i> A strong sherry aroma, big hints of fruit, sultana & cooking apples. Very pleasant & warming smell.			
<i>Sip:</i> Strong sherry arrival with fruit again and vanilla as with the nose and the famous undercurrent of salt.			
<i>Savour:</i> A long lingering finish with the salt fading but the fruit & vanilla holds strong.			
<b>Laphroaig</b>	<b>10 Year Old</b>	<b>43% abv</b>	<b>£5.00</b>
<i>Breathe In:</i> Huge smoke, seaweedy, "medicinal", with a hint of sweetness.			
<i>Sip:</i> Surprising sweetness with hints of salt & layers of peatiness.			
<i>Savour:</i> Long & Lingering.			

## Malts from Speyside...

<b>Aberlour</b>	<b>10 Year Old</b>	<b>40% abv</b>	<b>£4.50</b>
<i>Breathe in:</i> The dry, fresh, fruity aromas of early autumn apples & pears are subtly enhanced with sweet notes of vanilla.			
<i>Sip:</i> Exceptionally smooth & creamy, with spicy---sweet nutmeg & honey combining with the freshness of autumn fruits.			
<i>Savour:</i> Long, soft & warming			
<b>Balvenie Double Wood</b>	<b>12 Year Old</b>	<b>40% abv</b>	<b>£4.50</b>
<i>Breathe In:</i> The sherry comes through due to the second barreling style of production .			
<i>Sip:</i> Mellow, rich & smooth. A clever complexity that makes you pay attention to detail as you taste this very unique malt.			
<i>Savour:</i> Warming and long lasting. The sherry is evident, with a most interesting fullness.			
<b>Glenfiddich</b>	<b>12 Year Old</b>	<b>40% abv</b>	<b>£4.50</b>
<i>Breathe In:</i> Fresh & fragrant, touch of pear.			
<i>Sip:</i> Distinctive, well balanced flavours of rich fruit, subtle pine & a hint of peatiness.			
<i>Savour:</i> Satisfyingly long, lingering & rounded & smooth aftertaste			
<b>Glenlivet</b>	<b>12 Year Old</b>	<b>40% abv</b>	<b>£4.50</b>
<i>Breathe In:</i> Aromatic, with flowers. Clean & simple, with some maltiness. Sherry notes, some spice & vanilla.			
<i>Sip:</i> Subtle peatiness. Delicate and slightly sweet & fruity, with vanilla notes. Clean & well balanced.			
<i>Savour:</i> Long, but mild & warming. A trace of peat at the end.			
<b>Macallan</b>	<b>10 Year Old</b>	<b>40% abv</b>	<b>£5.00</b>
<i>Breathe In:</i> Complex, with hints of fruit & heather honey.			
<i>Sip:</i> Soft, with a maltiness, balanced with oak & fruit.			
<i>Savour:</i> Lingering with hints of oak & fruit.			
<b>Mortlach Rare &amp; Old</b>	<b>n/a</b>	<b>43.4% abv</b>	<b>£9.50</b>
<i>Breathe In:</i> Sugary biscuits, baked apple & crushed nuts. Fudge and herbal, leafy notes persist.			
<i>Sip:</i> Rich & full of palate, with spicy notes of cinnamon sticks, oak, vanilla, raisin and biscuit.			
<i>Savour:</i> Wow!! Warm and drying with cinnamon, pepper and vanilla. You won't forget this!			
<b>Singleton</b>	<b>12 Year Old</b>	<b>43% abv</b>	<b>£5.00</b>
<i>Breathe In:</i> Smooth, sweet, sherry & malty. Slight hint of peat.			
<i>Sip:</i> Taste confirms the nose, sherry, malty & a hint of peat.			
<i>Savour:</i> Lingering with sweet sherry.			

## Malts from the Highlands...

<b>Dalmore</b>	<b>12 Year Old</b>	<b>43% abv</b>	<b>£5.00</b>
<i>Breathe In:</i> Hints of Oloroso sherry lingers in the background. Fragrances of orange, marmalade & spice			
<i>Sip:</i> A fleshy body with great harmony. A concentrated citric taste captivates & tantalises the middle part of your tongue.			
<i>Savour:</i> An aftertaste of great abundance rewards. A Highland malt of great distinction.			
<b>Dalwhinnie</b>	<b>15 Year Old</b>	<b>43% abv</b>	<b>£5.00</b>
<i>Breath In:</i> Wholemeal & honey quality to the nose & slightly smoky.			
<i>Sip:</i> Lasting flavours of heather, honey sweetness & vanilla followed by deeper citrus.			
<i>Savour:</i> Long smooth, lingering, intense finish that starts sweetly, then smoky peat.			
<b>Glenmorangie</b>	<b>10 Year Old</b>	<b>40% abv</b>	<b>£4.50</b>
<i>Breathe in:</i> A rich nose, flower & spicy hints with some vanilla wood notes.			
<i>Sip:</i> The taste confirms the nose, delicate honey wood taste with a subtle hint of nuttiness.			
<i>Savour:</i> Smooth & relatively long.			



## Malts from the Islands...

<b>Arran</b>	<b>10 Year Old</b>	<b>46% abv</b>	<b>£4.50</b>
<i>Breathe In:</i> Herbal, biscuity, hedgerow greenness & dried grass, like a long English summer's afternoon.			
<i>Sip:</i> Sweet. Quite malty - digestive biscuits, followed by green fruits & Cox's apple peel.			
<i>Savour:</i> Slightly bitter, maltiness.			
<b>Highland Park</b>	<b>12 Year Old</b>	<b>40% abv</b>	<b>£5.00</b>
<i>Breathe In:</i> Heather honey sweetness; peaty smokiness.			
<i>Sip:</i> Rounded smoky sweetness; full malt delivery.			
<i>Savour:</i> Teasing, heathery, delicious.			
<b>Jura Superstition</b>	<b>n/a</b>	<b>43% abv</b>	<b>£5.00</b>
<i>Breathe In:</i> Light delicate phenolic aromas, with strong honey, spice, & cinnamon overtones.			
<i>Sip:</i> Add a little water & the delicate peat smoke will fill your mouth, mixed with the honey & spices.			
<i>Savour:</i> Long lasting balanced finish.			
<b>Springbank</b>	<b>10 Year Old</b>	<b>46% abv</b>	<b>£6.00</b>
<i>Breathe In:</i> Big---bodied with oaked aridity; peat is present & quite pungent with a note of exotic fruits and a hint of salinity.			
<i>Sip:</i> Full---bodied with a good helping of cereal sweetness. There is richness to the peat, with a nuttiness and whirling smoke.			
<i>Savour:</i> Long and crisp with a coastal tang and a trailing peat with oaked dryness.			
<b>Talisker</b>	<b>10 Year Old</b>	<b>45.8% abv</b>	<b>£5.00</b>
<i>Breathe In:</i> Powerful peat, smoke with seawater saltiness, the liquor of fresh oysters, a citrus sweetness.			
<i>Sip:</i> A rich dried fruit sweetness with clouds of smoke & strong barley malt flavours, warming & intense pepper.			
<i>Savour:</i> Huge, long, warming peppery finish with an appetising sweetness.			
<b>Talisker Skye</b>	<b>10 Year Old</b>	<b>45.8% abv</b>	<b>£6.00</b>
<i>Breathe In:</i> Lighter than Talisker 10, with background pepper and honey. A clever nose.			
<i>Sip:</i> Smokey brine with oranges & cooked pear and vanilla.			
<i>Savour:</i> You'd think that this wouldn't linger, but it does.			
<b>Talisker Storm</b>	<b>10 Year Old</b>	<b>45.8% abv</b>	<b>£6.00</b>
<i>Breathe In:</i> Rich & unexpectedly honeyed; some pleasing singed oaky notes with milk chocolate & apple fruit.			
<i>Sip:</i> Medium---full with initial honey & then a very decent dose of hot smoke. The oak is there too, with vanilla & pepper.			
<i>Savour:</i> Gets sweeter towards the end but the pepper lingers with unexpected sweet fruit & even a note of strawberry.			

## Our Scottish Gins...

<b>Blackwoods</b>	<b>40% abv</b>	<b>£3.25</b>
Blackwoods' 2012 vintage gin is made in the Shetlands using handpicked Shetland botanicals including juniper, angelica, marsh marigold, coriander, meadow sweet & sea pink. Handsome & tasty.		
<b>Edinburgh Elderflower Gin Liqueur</b>	<b>20% abv</b>	<b>£3.25</b>
A delightful floral gin with character emanates from this liqueur with fruity white berry notes. The palate has all the elderflower sweetness you could want, tempered by gin's naturally dry character. Clean & floral with a pleasing dryness. Rock		
<b>Rose Gin</b>	<b>43% abv</b>	<b>£3.25</b>
Rock Rose Gin is made at the Dunnet Bay Distillery, way up in Caithness. This gin features locally harvested Rhodiola Rosea, Rowan Berries, Sea Buckthorn, Blaeberry, Verbena, Coriander Seed, Cardamom & Juniper from two different countries --- Italy & Bulgaria. They use a traditional copper pot still, which of course has a name (it's Elizabeth)		
<b>The Botanist</b>	<b>46% abv</b>	<b>£3.75</b>
The Botanist Gin is a progressive exploration of the botanical heritage of the Isle of Islay. 22 hand-foraged local botanicals delicately augment nine berries, barks, seeds and peels during an achingly slow distillation. This first and only Islay Dry Gin is a rare expression of the heart and soul of this remote Scottish island.		
<b>Caorann</b>	<b>41.8% abv</b>	<b>£3.75</b>
A small batch Scottish gin from the Balmenach distillery in Speyside. Caorann (pronounced ka-roon), made with a combination of traditional & handpicked botanicals including rowan berry, heather, coul blush apple & dandelion.		
<b>Hendricks</b>	<b>41.4% abv</b>	<b>£3.75</b>
Quirky producer Hendricks make their pot-still distilled gin using cucumber as one of the primary botanicals. It's legendary for a unique fresh taste
